#### SNACK BAR PARENTAL CONSENT FORMS

## **DROP OFF/PICK UP RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**Please park your car** in the Member-Only parking lot and escort your child to the Ancala Ballroom for check-in each morning.

## Please do not drop child off prior to 8:00 am.

Do not park in front of the Clubhouse as it is imperative that the front circle remain clear of all standing and parked vehicles. Please be prompt.

It is very important that your child is picked up on time. There is a \$25.00 late pick up fee that will be strictly enforced.

#### **BEHAVIOR POLICY**
